	All senior compound archers will shoot on individual vertical triple 60cm faces.	
	All other categories will use shared single 60cm faces.	
	Entries for double sessions subject to availability.	
Awards	Trophies and medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awarded for single Portsmouth rounds and awarded	
	to competitors present at the ceremony.	
	If a competitor shoots both sessions, then only the first round shot is eligible for an award.
