<b>Venue</b>	Churston Grammar School Sports Field, Brixham, Devon, TQ5 0LH Parking at Brixham Archers Churston field (what3words: streaks.bucket.truffles) <a href="https://what3words.com/streaks.bucket.truffles">https://what3words.com/streaks.bucket.truffles</a> Please note the entrance lane is 1 vehicle wide and priority is given to incoming traffic.
<b>Rounds</b>	World Record Status Double WA 70m, WA 60m, WA 50m (Compound) & WA 50m (Barebow)
<b>Awards</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> places will be awarded in all categories
<b>Registration &amp; Session times</b>	Entry to the venue from 08:00 Registration from 08:30 Assembly 9.30am followed by up to 45 minutes of practice. Please ensure you bring your proof of AGB membership for presentation at registration.
<b>Shooting</b>	Four archers per boss in two details of two. All arrows will be shot in ends of 6 in 4 minutes. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All Recurve/Longbow Senior and U21 will shoot 70m at a 122cm face.</li><li>• All Recurve/Longbow 50+ and U18 will shoot 60m at a 122cm face.</li><li>• All Barebow will shoot at 50m at a 122cm face.</li><li>• All Compound will shoot 50m at individual 80cm faces (5 zone scoring).</li><li>• Archery GB U16-U12 Metric Rounds if space is available (please email TO if interested).</li></ul>
<b>Arrows</b>	The venue is a school sports field and all arrows <b>MUST</b> be found. It is the archer's responsibility to ensure that all arrows and parts of are accounted for and not left on the field. Remember that metal detectors will not detect full-carbon arrows. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.

<b>Drug Testing</b>	Record status tournaments will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached.
